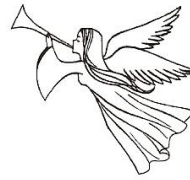

Health and hygiene classes will be taught and evangelism will be done with both adults and children. We will also continue mechanical inspection and repairs on previously drilled wells.

Through God's gift of water, we strive to fulfill the commandment of Christ to make disciples who share the "living water" of the Gospel with others.
